Ramle: Creating Private Space for a 16-Yr Old in a Crowded Home With 7 Children...

Miriam, a recently-divorced mother living in a cramped apartment with her 7 children, dreamed of giving her 16 year-old son some desperately needed privacy. Since he shared a small room with the family's 7-month old baby, his sleep schedule revolved around hers and he had no quiet space to prepare homework. As part of our general repairs for the family, our creative work team carved out a new bedroom from the apartment's existing living room. The mother reports a sea-change in her son's personality. He is now performing better in school and has become more helpful around the house. This demonstrates how home repairs can result in far-reaching benefits for our clients.

Rapid Pace of Work Continues into 2018: 70 Families Served in Jan-Feb
